Call for abstracts:

The 3rd International Congress on 21st–Century Literacies (ICCL2024), which will take place on November 29 and 30, 2024, at the Polytechnic Institute of Beja, aims to promote and rethink literacy in different areas of knowledge as part of the right to education.

ICCL2024 will provide a forum of interest to the scientific community in general, in which reflections will be stimulated on the key competences for exercising informed, critical, and participatory citizenship in a society that is constantly and rapidly changing and evolving.

The aim is for this meeting to be an opportunity for new scientific collaborations between national and foreign researchers.

The event is open to the entire scientific and academic community (with or without oral/poster communication) and will have a hybrid format (face-to-face and online).

Participants with or without an oral or poster presentation must register by filling in the following form <u>Registration Form.</u>

Abstract submission

Abstracts should follow the abstract <u>template</u>. All abstracts should be sent via the <u>Registration Form.</u>

Participation: face-to-face or virtual

Methods of participation:

- Oral presentation
- Poster presentation (only for face-to-face participation)
- Listener

Oral papers will be presented in **thematic sessions**. In these sessions, authors will have <u>10 minutes</u> to present their work. Authors can participate in oral presentations in person or virtually.

The presentation of a **poster** implies that the authors are <u>present in person</u>. The printing of posters is the responsibility of the authors, who must hand them in for display at the time set for check-in. Poster papers will be on display during the event and will be pitched by the authors at the exhibition venue, in a session that will take place before the morning coffee break.

Session/Symposium Organization/Registration

Participants can submit proposals for a Thematic Session/Symposium (Oral Communication or Poster) by filling in the <u>Organizer Application Form</u> by September 30, 2024.

The Thematic Session/Symposium must have at least 4 speakers (including the organizer). Language of presentation: English, Portuguese, or Spanish.

Publication

Full texts (optional) of the papers presented at ICCL2024 may be submitted for publication:

- in the ICCL2024 Proceedings

The limit is 8 pages (including figures/tables and references).

When submitting full papers based on accepted abstracts, please use the following <u>template</u>.

The articles will be evaluated by at least 2 reviewers from the ICCL2024 Scientific Committee.

The final version of the articles must be sent to <u>21centuryliteracies@gmail.com</u> by December 30, 2024.

- in the Latin American Journal of Development



Articles must comply with the journal's editorial standards and will be subject to peer review.

- in the Brazilian Electronic Journal of Mathematics (BEJOM)



The authors of the works presented at the congress will be able to submit the corresponding articles (full texts) to the Brazilian Electronic Journal of Mathematics (BEJOM). These articles must fit into the journal's thematic areas, be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English, and comply with the journal's General Publication Standards. Articles will be analyzed by the BEJOM editorial board and subject to peer review. Articles that are accepted will be published after the review process.

(Full text submission is optional).
